




- What is Twinspace?
  - Twinspace is a secure online platform within eTwinning where both teachers and students collaboratively work on project-related tasks in a safe and controlled environment.
- Teacher's Perspective:
- Teachers utilize Twinspace for seamless project planning, document sharing, and real-time collaboration. It's a central space for coordinating activities, sharing best practices, and engaging in professional development.
- Student's Perspective:
  - Students benefit by actively participating in collaborative projects with peers worldwide. Twinspace provides a secure and interactive platform for students to share work, exchange ideas, and develop digital and intercultural competencies.



- 3. Click on Create a project






Your partner should possess a verified profile for both themselves and thier school.


Choose your school and your partner school.

Proceed to respond to all the questions related to your project.

Inform your partner to give their approval.
Following that, your National Support Service (NSS)
will review it and approve within a short time.



Upon project approval, an email from NSS will be sent to you. Subsequently, log in to your account and navigate to "My Twinspaces.

In 'My Twinspaces,' you will find your approved project.





Simply select the project, go to the 'Pages' section, and start the design process.






# Follow the steps below.
